**The A449 & A40 Trunk Roads (Usk  
to Raglan, Monmouthshire)  
(Temporary Traffic Restrictions &  
Prohibitions) Order 2011**

*Made* 31 August 2011

*Coming into force* 12 September 2011

The Welsh Ministers, being the traffic authority for the relevant length of the Newport – Worcester Trunk Road (A449/A40) (hereinafter referred to as “the trunk road(s)”), are satisfied that traffic in a specified length of the trunk road(s) should be restricted or prohibited by reason of works being executed thereon.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1) and of all other enabling powers(2), make this Order.

1. This Order comes into force on 12 September 2011 and its title is The A449 & A40 Trunk Roads (Usk to Raglan, Monmouthshire) (Temporary Traffic Restrictions & Prohibitions) Order 2011.

2. —(1) In this Order:

“exempted vehicle” (*“cerbyd esempt”*) means any vehicle being used for the emergency services or in connection with the works giving rise to this Order;

“the lengths of the trunk roads” (*“y darnau o’r cefnffyrdd”*) means those lengths of the A449 and A40 trunk roads between Usk and Raglan in the County of Monmouthshire specified in the Schedules to this Order;

“works period” (*“cyfnod y gwaith”*) means the period commencing at 20:00 hours on 12 September 2011 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed.
