**The National Curriculum (Amendments to the Key Stage 2 and Key Stage 3 Assessment Arrangements) (Wales) Order 2011**

The Welsh Ministers in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by sections 108(3)(c), (7), (8), (9), (10) and (11) and 210(7) of the Education Act 2002<sup>(1)</sup> make the following Order:

**Title, commencement and application**

1.—(1) The title of this Order is the National Curriculum (Amendments to the Key Stage 2 and Key Stage 3 Assessment Arrangements) (Wales) Order 2011 and it comes into force on 1 September 2011.

(2) This Order applies to maintained schools in Wales.

**National Curriculum (Key Stage 2 Assessment Arrangements) (Wales) Order 2004**

2. The National Curriculum (Key Stage 2 Assessment Arrangements) (Wales) Order 2004<sup>(2)</sup> is amended as follows—

(a) in article 3(1), after the definition of “summer term” insert—

““working day” (“*diwrnod gwaith*”) means any day other than a Saturday, Sunday or a day which is a bank holiday within the meaning of section 1 of the Banking and Financial Dealings Act 1971<sup>(3)</sup>.”; and

(b) in article 4(3) for “two weeks” substitute “twenty working days”.
