**The A40 Trunk Road (Travellers
Rest to Pensarn Roundabout,
Carmarthenshire) (Temporary
Traffic Restrictions and
Prohibitions) Order 2011**

Made *21 July 2011*

Coming into force *1 August 2011*

The Welsh Ministers, being the traffic authority for the relevant lengths of the London – Fishguard Trunk Road (A40) (hereinafter referred to as “the trunk road”), are satisfied that traffic in specified lengths of the trunk road should be restricted and prohibited by reason of works proposed to be executed thereon.

The Welsh Ministers, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1) and of all other enabling powers(2), make this Order.

1. This Order comes into force on 1 August 2011. The title to this Order is The A40 Trunk Road (Travellers Rest to Pensarn Roundabout, Carmarthenshire) (Temporary Traffic Restrictions and Prohibitions) Order 2011.

2. —1) In this Order:

“the lengths of the trunk road” (“*y darnau o’r gefnffordd*”) means the lengths of the A40 London – Fishguard Trunk Road from Travellers Rest to Pensarn Roundabout in the County of Carmarthenshire described in the Schedule to this Order;

“works period,” (“*cyfnod y gwaith*”) means that period commencing at 19.00 hours on 1 August 2011 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed.

“exempted vehicle” (“*cerbyd esempt*”) means any vehicle being used by the emergency services or in connection with the works giving rise to this Order.
