The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by section 483(1) and (4) of the Companies Act 2006⁽¹⁾ and of all other powers enabling them to do so.

In accordance with section 483(2) of the Companies Act 2006, it appears to Scottish Ministers that Scottish Rail Holdings Limited is entirely or substantially funded from a body having accounts falling within paragraph (a) or (b) of section 483(3) of that Act.

In accordance with section 483(5) of that Act, a draft of the Order has been laid before, and approved by resolution of, the Scottish Parliament.

Citation, commencement and interpretation

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Companies Act 2006 (Scottish public sector companies to be audited by the Auditor General for Scotland) Order 2022 and comes into force on the day after it is made.

(2) In this Order “the Company” means Scottish Rail Holdings Limited, a private limited company bearing company number SC548826 and having its registered office at Buchanan House, Port Dundas Road, Glasgow, Scotland, G4 0HF.

2. The accounts of the Company are to be audited by the Auditor General for Scotland.
