The Trade in Animals and Related Products (EU Exit) (Scotland) (Amendment) Regulations 2021

The Scottish Ministers make the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by paragraphs 1(1) and (3) of schedule 2 of the European Union (Withdrawal) Act 2018⁽¹⁾ and of all other powers enabling them to do so.

In accordance with paragraph 1(6) of schedule 7 of that Act, a draft of this instrument has been laid before and approved by resolution of the Scottish Parliament.

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Trade in Animals and Related Products (EU Exit) (Scotland) (Amendment) Regulations 2021 and come into force on the day after the day on which they are made.

Amendment of the Trade in Animals and Related Products (Scotland) Regulations 2012

2. In schedule 2 (additional requirements in specific cases) of the Trade in Animals and Related Products (Scotland) Regulations 2012⁽²⁾ after paragraph 10 insert—

“Special import conditions: products of animal origin

10A.—(1) The Scottish Ministers may by regulations impose special import conditions in respect of imports from third countries of products of animal origin intended for human
