**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The M6 Motorway (Junctions 4 to 3, Warwickshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2015**

*Made - - - - 9th March 2015*

*Coming into force - - 16th March 2015*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M6 Motorway (“the M6”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on a length of the M6 and some of those connecting roads, in the County of Warwickshire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the M6 Motorway (Junctions 4 to 3, Warwickshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2015 and shall come into force on Monday 16th March 2015.

2. In this Order –

“the motorway”

means –

- a) the eastbound carriageway of the M6 from the junction with the exit slip road at Junction 4, to the junction with the entry slip road at Junction 3;
- b) the westbound carriageway of the M6 from the junction with the exit slip road at Junction 3, to the junction with the entry slip road at Junction 4;

“a slip road”

means the slip roads leading –

- a) to the eastbound carriageway of the M6 at Junction 4;
- b) from the eastbound carriageway of the M6 to Corley Motorway Service Area;
- c) to the eastbound carriageway of the M6 from Corley Motorway Service Area;
- d) from the eastbound carriageway of the M6 at Junction 3;
