**The A66 Trunk Road (Stainmore Layby) (Temporary
Prohibition and Restriction of Traffic) Order 2015**

Made - - - - *12th February 2015*

Coming into force - - *1st March 2015*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport being the traffic authority for the A66 Trunk Road is satisfied that traffic on that trunk road in the District of Eden in the County of Cumbria, should be restricted and prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A66 Trunk Road (Stainmore Layby) (Temporary Prohibition and Restriction of Traffic) Order 2015 and shall come into force on 1st March 2015.

2. In this Order:

“the trunk road” means the A66 Trunk Road:

“the first length of carriageway” means the eastbound carriageway from a point 532 metres east of the centreline at the junction with Banksgate Farm access road to a point 113 metres east of the centreline at the Old Spittal Farm access;

“the second length of carriageway” means the westbound carriageway of the trunk road from a point 113 metres east of the centreline at the Old Spittal Farm access to a point 527 metres east of the centreline at the junction with the Barrenthwaite Hall access;

“layby” means an area of carriageway, intended for the waiting of vehicles, bounded partly by a road marking on the outer edge of that carriageway complying with diagram 1010 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002(b);

“the layby to be closed” means the layby adjacent to the eastbound carriageway of the trunk road at a point 2080 metres east of the centreline of Palliard Cottage access;

“the works period” means a period starting at 0001 hours on Monday 2nd March 2015 and ending at 2359 hours on Sunday 26th April 2015. Works may start and continue beyond these dates for such period not exceeding 18 months as shall be required to complete the work;
