THE TRADING WITH THE ENEMY (ENEMY TERRITORY CESSATION) (DODECANESE ISLANDS) ORDER, 1947, DATED MARCH 14, 1947, MADE BY THE BOARD OF TRADE.

1947 No. 461

The Board of Trade in pursuance of the powers conferred upon them by Section 1 of the Trading with the Enemy Act, 1939 (hereinafter called "the Act"), Regulation 7 of the Defence (Trading with the Enemy) Regulations, 1940(a), and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby order as follows:— 2 & 3 Geo. 6. c. 89.

1. The Dodecanese Islands shall for all purposes of the Act and for the purposes of any order made thereunder cease to be treated as if they were enemy territory as from the date of this Order.

2. Notwithstanding anything contained in Section 1 of the Act, any person, unless the Board of Trade otherwise direct, may trade within the Dodecanese Islands with any individual or body of persons (whether corporate or unincorporate) carrying on business therein.

3. This Order may be cited as the Trading with the Enemy (Enemy Territory Cessation) (Dodecanese Islands) Order, 1947.
