THE TRADING WITH THE ENEMY (AUTHORISATION) (POLAND) ORDER, 1946, DATED JULY 9, 1946, MADE BY THE BOARD OF TRADE.

c. 89. The Board of Trade in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by Sections 1 and 5 of the Trading with the Enemy Act, 1939 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act"), and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf do hereby make the following Order:—

1. Notwithstanding anything contained in Section 1 of the Act, any person unless the Board of Trade otherwise direct may trade within Poland with any individual or body of persons (whether corporate or unincorporate) carrying on business therein.

2. The transfer by or on behalf of any person within the description contained in Article 3 of this Order of any annuities, stocks, shares, bonds, debentures or debenture stock registered or inscribed in any
