THE TRADING WITH THE ENEMY (CUSTODIAN) (AMENDMENT) ORDER, 1946, DATED JULY 6, 1946, MADE BY THE BOARD OF TRADE UNDER SECTION 7 OF TRADING WITH THE ENEMY ACT, 1939 (2 & 3 Geo. 6. c. 89).

The Board of Trade in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by Section 7 of the Trading with the Enemy Act, 1939, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf do hereby make the following Order:—

- 1. Articles 1, 4 and 5 of the Trading with the Enemy (Custodian) Order, 1939(a) (requiring payment of certain monies to the Custodian and imposing restrictions and requirements in regard to certain property in the United Kingdom) shall not apply to—
 - (a) any money which would but for the existence of a state of war become payable to or for the benefit of any person within the description contained in Article 2 of this Order on or after the 9th July, 1946;
 - (b) any property which on or after the 9th July, 1946, comes into the ownership of any such person as aforesaid.
 - 2. This Order applies—
 - (a) to any individual resident in any territory which has at no time been enemy territory;
 - (b) as respects any business carried on in the territory aforesaid to any individual or body of persons (whether corporate or unincorporate) carrying on that business.
- 3. This Order may be cited as the Trading with the Enemy (Custodian) (Amendment) Order, 1946, and shall come into force on 9th July, 1946.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport)

By an Order (S. R. & O. 1946 No. 1041) dated 6th July, 1946, which came into force on 9th July, 1946, the Board of Trade revoked the Lists of Specified Persons issued under Section 2 (2) of the Trading with the Enemy Act, 1939. There are, however, persons resident in or carrying on business in neutral countries and other territory who remain enemies under the Trading with the Enemy Act, notwithstanding the revocation of the Specified Persons Lists with whom it would remain an offence
