

**(3) Amendment of Commissioners of Works
Act, 1852**

ORDER IN COUNCIL AMENDING SECTION 2 OF THE
COMMISSIONERS OF WORKS ACT, 1852 (15 & 16
VICT. c. 28).

At the Court at Buckingham Palace, the 20th day of December, 1945

The King's Most Excellent Majesty in Council

Whereas in exercise of the powers conferred on Him by the Minister of Works Act, 1942, His Majesty in Council was pleased to make the Ministry of Works (Transfer of Powers) (No. 1) Order, 1945 (a) and it appears to His Majesty to be expedient, having regard to the transfer effected by that Order, to make the incidental provision hereinafter contained :

Now, therefore, His Majesty, in exercise of the powers conferred on Him as aforesaid, is pleased, by and with the advice of His Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows :—

1. In Section 2 of the Commissioners of Works Act, 1852, for the words "by the Direction of the Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury" there shall be substituted the words "with the consent of the Treasury which may be given either generally for any class of case, or for any particular transaction."

2.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Commissioners of Works Act, 1852 (Amendment) Order, 1945.
