- (c) in accordance with paragraph 7(1)(b) and (c) of Schedule 14 to the 2000 Act, considered any representations made to the Secretary of State about the draft and, as thought appropriate, modified the draft accordingly; and
- (d) in accordance with paragraph 7(2) of Schedule 14 to the 2000 Act, laid a draft of the code of practice before Parliament.
