**FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE**

**The Energy Payment Support Scheme  
(Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2022**

*Made* - - - - *09th March 2022*

*Coming into operation* *10th March 2022*

The First Minister and deputy First Minister, acting jointly, made on 18th January 2022 a determination under section 1(1) of the Financial Assistance Act (Northern Ireland) 2009<sup>(1)</sup>; and, acting jointly, they have designated the Department for Communities<sup>(2)</sup> as the relevant department under section 1(3)(a) of that Act.

Accordingly, the Department for Communities, makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 1(2) and 3(1)(e), (h) and (i) of that Act.

In accordance with section 1(4) of that Act, the Executive Office<sup>(3)</sup> approves the making of these Regulations.

**Citation and commencement**

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Energy Payment Support Scheme (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2022 and shall come into operation on 10th March 2022.

**Amendment to the Energy Payment Support Scheme Regulations**

2.—(1) The Energy Payment Support Scheme Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2022<sup>(4)</sup> are amended in accordance with paragraph (2).

(2) After paragraph 5 of the Schedule (appeals) insert—

**“Payment to be disregarded for social security**

**5A.** No account shall be taken of eligibility for an Energy Payment in considering a person’s entitlement to a payment under any of the following social security benefits:
