**PUBLIC SERVICE PENSIONS**

**The Public Service Pensions Act (Northern Ireland)  
2014 (Judicial Offices) Order (Northern Ireland) 2015**

*Coming into operation* *1st April 2015*

The Department of Justice makes this Order in exercise of the power conferred by paragraph 2 of Schedule 1 to the Public Service Pensions Act (Northern Ireland) 2014 <sup>F1</sup>

**Citation and commencement**

1. This Order may be cited as the Public Service Pensions Act (Northern Ireland) 2014 (Judicial Offices) Order (Northern Ireland) 2015 and comes into operation on 1st April 2015.

**Interpretation**

2. For the purposes of this Order, an office is “held on a salaried basis” if service in that office is remunerated by payment of a salary.

**Judicial Offices**

3. A person who holds one of the offices specified in the Schedule is a holder of judicial office for the purposes of section 1(2)(b) of the Public Service Pensions Act (Northern Ireland) 2014.
