ROAD TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES

Traffic Weight Restriction (Armagh) Order
(Northern Ireland) 1988

Made 12th September 1988

Coming into operation 23rd October 1988

WHEREAS the Department of the Environment has published notice in compliance with Article 23(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981(a);

AND WHEREAS no objection has been received;

NOW THEREFORE the Department in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 22(1) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981 and of every other power enabling it in that behalf and being satisfied that the lengths of road specified in the Schedule are unsuitable for use by certain classes of vehicles makes the following Order:—

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Weight Restriction (Armagh) Order (Northern Ireland) 1988 and shall come into operation on 23rd October 1988.

Prohibition

2. Subject to Article 3 the use by vehicles exceeding 3 tonnes in weight, whether laden or unladen, of the lengths of road specified in the Schedule is prohibited.

Exemptions

3. The prohibitions in Article 2 shall not apply to vehicles being used:—

- (a) either by the owners or occupiers of land abutting on or convenient to the said lengths of road; or
- (b) in connection with the delivery to or collection from such land of goods of any kind or in connection with public utility or emergency services.
