Limits of Benefits

ORDER, DATED 18TH DECEMBER 1973, MADE BY THE REGISTRAR OF FRIENDLY SOCIETIES, WITH THE CONSENT OF THE MINISTRY OF COMMERCE, UNDER SECTION 55(4) OF THE FRIENDLY SOCIETIES ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1970.

The Registrar, with the consent of the Ministry of Commerce, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 55(4) of the Friendly Societies Act (Northern Ireland) 1970(a), hereby makes the following Order:—

Citation

1. This Order may be cited as the Friendly Societies (Limits of Benefits) Order (Northern Ireland) 1973.

Limits of benefits

- 2. The limits in paragraphs (c) and (d) of sub-section (1) of section 55 of the Friendly Societies Act (Northern Ireland) 1970, as increased by the Friendly Societies (Limits of Benefits) Order (Northern Ireland) 1970(b), (which govern the amount which members of registered friendly societies and branches may be entitled to receive under life or endowment business which is not tax exempt) shall be further increased as follows:—
 - (a) the limit of £3,500 shall be increased to £5,000;
 - (b) the limit of £5,000 (relating to mortgage protection policies) shall be increased to £7,250;
 - (c) the limit of £350 (relating to annuities) shall be increased to £500.
