WEIGHTS AND MEASURES

Weights and Measures (Salt) Order (Northern Ireland) 1973

Coming into Operation . . . 1st January 1975

To be laid before the Parliament of the United Kingdom under paragraph 4(5)(b) of the Schedule to the Northern Ireland (Temporary Provisions) Act 1972.

WHEREAS the Ministry of Commerce pursuant to section 35(2) of the Weights and Measures Act (Northern Ireland) 1967(a) (hereinafter referred to at "the Act") has consulted with organisations appearing to it to be representative of interests substantially affected by this Order and considered the representations made to it by such organisations with respect to the subject matter of this Order:

The Ministry of Commerce on behalf of the Secretary of State and in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 15(2), (3) and (5) of the Act and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:—

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Weights and Measures (Salt) Order (Northern Ireland) 1973 and shall come into operation on 1st January 1975.

2. Part VIII of Schedule 2 to the Act shall cease to apply to salt.

3. Salt which is not pre-packed shall be sold by retail only by net weight.

4. Subject to Article 5 of this Order salt, other than cut lump salt, shall be pre-packed only if:

- (a) it is made up in one of the following quantities by net weight, that is to say:
 - (i) 4 oz, 8 oz, 12 oz, 1 lb, $1\frac{1}{2}$ lb, or a multiple of 1 lb; or
 - (ii) 125 g, 250 g, 500 g, 750 g, 1 kg, 1.5 kg, or a multiple of one kg up to and including 10 kg, 12.5 kg, 25 kg or 50 kg; and

(b) the container is marked with an indication of quantity by net weight.

5. Salt shall be exempted from all requirements of Article 4(a) of this Order if pre-packed in a quantity not exceeding 100g.
