**SUMMARY JURISDICTION****Petty Sessions Districts and Times**

ORDER, DATED 22ND NOVEMBER 1973, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS UNDER SECTION 21(3) OF THE MAGISTRATES' COURTS ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1964.

The Ministry of Home Affairs on behalf of the Secretary of State and in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 21(3) of the Magistrates' Courts Act (Northern Ireland) 1964(a) and after consultation with the County Court Judges and Resident Magistrates concerned hereby orders and directs as follows:—

*Citation and commencement*

1. This Order may be cited as the Petty Sessions Districts and Times (No. 2) Order (Northern Ireland) 1973 and shall come into operation on the 1st day of January 1974.

*Times of holding of Belfast, Bangor, Holywood, Newcastle, Dungannon, Omagh, Plumbridge and Strabane Petty Sessions*

2. Petty Sessions shall be held regularly for the Belfast, Bangor, Holywood, Newcastle, Dungannon, Omagh, Plumbridge and Strabane Petty Sessions Districts at the times set out in the Schedule to this Order.

*Revocations*

3. The Petty Sessions Districts and Times (General) Order (Northern Ireland) 1972(b) in so far as it relates to the times and sittings of Belfast, Bangor, Holywood, Newcastle, Dungannon, Omagh, Plumbridge and Strabane Petty Sessions is hereby revoked.
