REGULATIONS, DATED 10TH SEPTEMBER 1973, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES UNDER THE NATIONAL INSURANCE (INDUSTRIAL INJURIES) ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1966.

The Ministry of Health and Social Services on behalf of the Secretary of State, in exercise of powers conferred by section 71 of the National Insurance (Industrial Injuries) Act (Northern Ireland) 1966(a) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following regulations being regulations subject to negative resolution in accordance with section 80(2) of the said Act:

Citation and commencement

1. These regulations may be cited as the National Insurance (Industrial Injuries) (Mariners) Amendment Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1973 and shall come into operation on 1st October 1973.

Amendment of the National Insurance (Industrial Injuries) (Mariners) Regulations

2. In regulation 6(b) (contributions in respect of masters or members of the crew of ships or vessels other than home-trade ships) of the National Insurance (Industrial Injuries) (Mariners) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1948(c), for the amounts "£0.008" and "£0.004" there shall be substituted the amounts "£0.009" and "£0.005" respectively.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general purport.)

These regulations amend the provisions of the National Insurance (Industrial Injuries) (Mariners) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1948 relating to contributions in respect of masters or members of the crew of ships or vessels other than home-trade ships (regulation 2).
