Secondary Schools (Grant Conditions)

REGULATIONS, DATED 30TH AUGUST 1973, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE UNDER THE EDUCATION ACTS (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1947 TO 1971.

The Ministry of Education (hereinafter called "the Ministry") on behalf of the Secretary of State and in pursuance of the powers vested in it by sections 104 and 112 of the Education Act (Northern Ireland) 1947(a) and Section 8 of the Education (Amendment) Act (Northern Ireland) 1966(b) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf and with the approval of the Ministry of Finance, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Secondary Schools (Grant Conditions) Amending Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1973.

(2) These Regulations shall be deemed to have come into operation on 1st April 1973.

2. The existing Regulations hereby amended are the Secondary Schools (Grant Conditions) Regulations 1965(c).

3. The following paragraph is hereby substituted for paragraph 1 of the First Schedule to the existing Regulations.

"Salary Grant

1. Salary Grant shall be payable in respect of each recognised teacher appointed to the authorised staff of a voluntary grammar school by the school authorities with the approval of the Ministry and shall be an annual rate equal to two-thirds of the amount by which the annual rate of salary and allowances payable to the teacher under the Regulations exceeds the rate of £800 per annum from 1st April 1973.

Provided that in respect of any period of absence, owing to illness, in respect of which a teacher is paid half salary, the salary grant payable by the Ministry in respect of him for the period shall be half the salary grant that would normally be payable."
