HOUSING EXECUTIVE ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1971

ORDER, DATED 24TH MARCH 1972, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF DEVELOPMENT UNDER THE HOUSING EXECUTIVE ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1971.

The Ministry of Development in pursuance of the powers conferred on it by section 9(1) of the Housing Executive Act (Northern Ireland 1971(a) and of all other powers it thereunto enabling hereby makes the following Order:—

1. The Northern Ireland Housing Trust shall be dissolved as from the 31st March 1972.

2. The Housing Executive Act (Dissolution of the Northern Ireland Housing Trust) Order (Northern Ireland) 1971(b) (which is invalid in so far as it provided for the dissolution of the said Trust on the date thereof) is hereby formally revoked except in so far as it specified the 4th October 1971 as the day specified for the purposes of section 10 of the Housing Executive Act (Northern Ireland) 1971.

3. This order may be cited as the Housing Executive Act (Revocation) Order 1972.
