Gosford Forest Park

REGULATIONS, DATED 18TH APRIL 1969, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE UNDER SECTION 14 OF THE FORESTRY ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1953.

The Ministry of Agriculture for Northern Ireland, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by Section 14 of the Forestry Act (Northern Ireland) 1953(a) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, and with the consent of the Ministry of Finance for Northern Ireland, hereby makes the following Regulation:—

1. This Regulation may be cited as the Forestry (Gosford) Regulation (Northern Ireland) 1969 and shall come into operation on 30th day of May 1969.

2. In this Regulation, unless the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the meaning hereby assigned to them, that is to say:

“the Act” means the Forestry Act (Northern Ireland) 1953;

“the Ministry” means the Ministry of Agriculture.

3. Whereas by Section 14 of the Act it is provided that the Ministry may, subject to the consent of the Ministry of Finance, declare that any land owned by the Ministry shall be treated as a Northern Ireland Forest Park (hereinafter referred to as “a Forest Park”) and thereupon the public shall have access to that land.

Now, therefore, the Ministry hereby declares that those parts of the lands owned by it and commonly known as Gosford Demesne, situated in the townlands of Drumlack and Gosford Demesne, in the Barony of Fews Lower, in the Administrative County of Armagh, containing 573 acres or thereabouts, statute measure, as delineated by a red line but excluding the area coloured green on the map sealed with the Official Seal of the Ministry on the same date as this Regulation and deposited at the offices of the Ministry at Dundonald House in the County of Down, shall be a Forest Park to which, subject to and in accordance with such bye-laws as may be made, the public shall have access.
