

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This note is not part of the Regulations but is intended to indicate their general purport.)*

These Regulations amend the provisions of the existing Regulations in regard to the notice to be given to the employing authority by a teacher who intends to be absent from teaching duties owing to childbirth and also the conditions for payment of salary after resumption of duty.

**RESIDENT MAGISTRATES: SALARIES AND ALLOWANCES**

ORDER, DATED 23RD JANUARY 1967, MADE BY THE MINISTER OF HOME AFFAIRS WITH THE CONCURRENCE OF THE MINISTER OF FINANCE, UNDER SECTION 12(1) OF THE MAGISTRATES' COURTS ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1964.

I, The Right Honourable William Craig, Minister of Home Affairs for Northern Ireland, in exercise of the powers conferred on me by Section 12(1) of the Magistrates' Courts Act (Northern Ireland) 1964(a) do hereby make the following Order:—

*Citation and Commencement*

1. This Order may be cited as the Resident Magistrates (Salaries and Allowances) Order (Northern Ireland) 1967 and shall have effect as from the 19th November 1966.

*Revocation*

2. The Resident Magistrates (Salaries and Allowances) No. 2 Order (Northern Ireland) 1964(b) is hereby revoked.

*Salaries of Resident Magistrates*

3.—(1) The annual salary payable to a Resident Magistrate appointed for the City of Belfast shall be £4,825.

(2) The annual salary payable to every other Resident Magistrate shall be £4,575.
