day of production (with the words 'morning' or 'evening' according to the time of milking), and the words 'Grade A.' The label shall be green in colour and the churn shall also bear upon the neck the words 'Grade A' inscribed in green letters at least four inches in height, but no other words relating to the quality of the milk.

Every carton to which milk is transferred under this regulation shall be sealed forthwith. The carton shall be white or cream in colour, and shall bear, in green letters, the name and address of the distributor or of the premises where the milk is transferred to the carton, the day of production and the words 'Grade A Milk,' but no other words relating to the quality of the milk may be added."

3. These Regulations may be cited as the Milk (Grade A) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1936, and these Regulations, the principal Regulations, and the Milk (Grade A) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1935(b), shall be construed together and may be cited as the Milk (Grade A) (Amended) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1936.

## Milk Regulations : Grade B.

THE MILK (GRADE B) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1936, DATED 23RD DAY OF JUNE, 1936, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE FOR NORTHERN IRELAND UNDER SECTION NINE OF THE MILK AND MILK PRODUCTS ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1934 (24 AND 25 GEO. V. CH. 16).

The Ministry of Agriculture for Northern Ireland in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Section nine of the Milk and Milk Products Act (Northern Ireland), 1934, and of any other powers enabling it on that behalf, hereby makes the following regulations, that is to say :---
