

THE ZAMBIA CORRECTIONAL SERVICE BILL, 2021

MEMORANDUM

The objects of this Bill are to—

- (a) continue the existence of the Zambia Prisons Service and rename it as the Zambia Correctional Service and redefine its functions;
- (b) provide for the establishment, management and control of prisons and correctional centres;
- (c) provide for the correction and reformation of inmates;
- (d) establish the Directorate of Extension Services and provide for its functions;
- (e) provide for compulsory aftercare orders;
- (f) establish the National Parole Board and provide for its functions;
- (g) domesticate the United Nations Standard Minimum Rules for Treatment of Prisoners;
- (h) repeal and replace the Prisons Act, 1965; and
- (i) provide for matters connected with, or incidental to the foregoing.
