PART I

PURPOSE AND CONTEXT

Introduction

1. FAO Statistical Development Series No. 2, E the 1990 World Census of Agriculture (FAO, Rome, after called the World Programme or WP, has been for use in all countries of the world. However, considerations may apply within different Regions of countries across the world. The purpose of the Pacific Region supplement to the WP is to take into consideration that are likely to apply to countries in the Asia and Pacific Region. Most of the countries in the Region have participated in the World Census of Agriculture (WCA) Programmes sponsored by FAO in the past and have gained valuable experience in conducting the census. However, these countries vary a great deal with respect to food and agricultural statistical infrastructure, agricultural and rural environment, socio-economic conditions that influence the conduct of an agricultural census.

2. For the purpose of the WP, the Asia and Pacific Region is broadly defined to comprise the following countries:
