PLASTICS LIKE THIS BLOCK THE DRAINAGE SYSTEM.

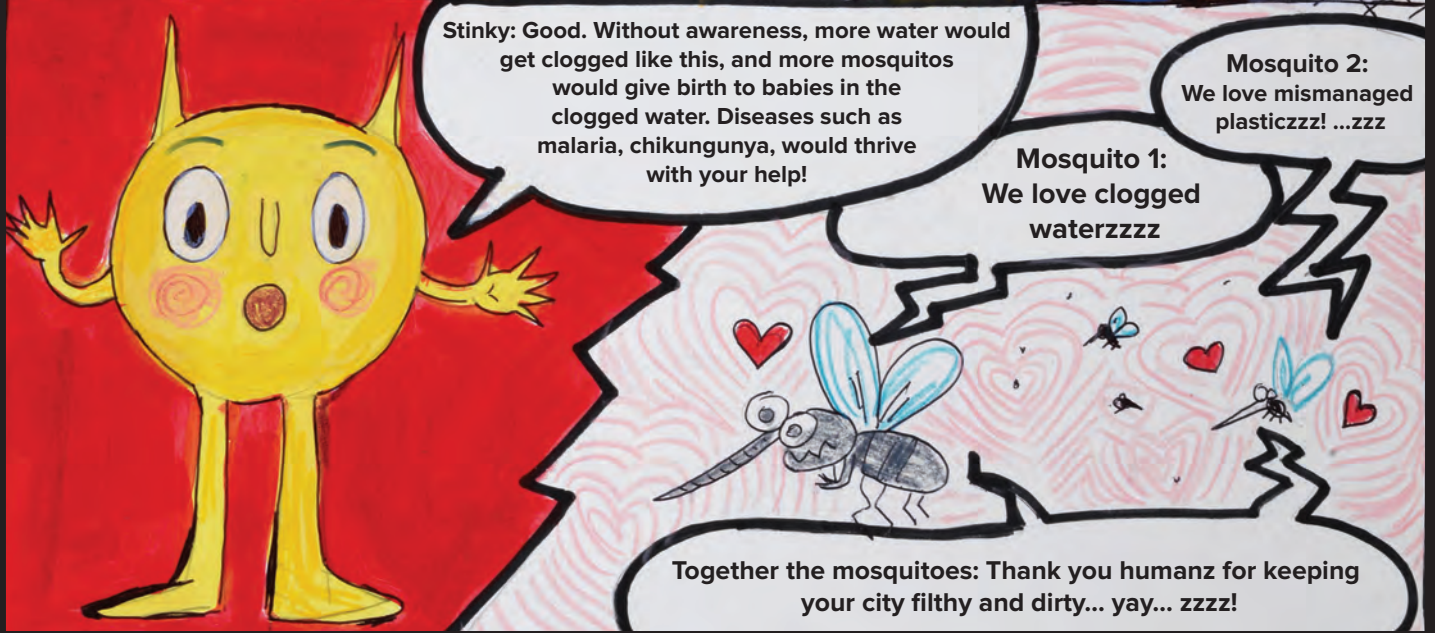
I didn't know, sorry!
