

The richest fifth of the World's Population receives 83% of the Worlds Income 83% 1.4 billion

One fifth of the Worlds Population (20 percentile)

The poorest fifth of the Worlds Population receives 1.4% of total World Income

Ratio of 60:1 between highest and lowest 20%!! Persistent Poverty, Growing Inequality



Why do we need Green Economy?ICIMOD

- The Rio declaration "The Future We Want" integration of economic, social & environment into economic development
- Green economy aims to enhance human well being, social equity and reduce environmental risks & ecological scarcities
- GE is a means to sustainable development
- Balanced development of 3 Pillars
 - Economic: sustained growth, quality growth
 - Social: inequalities, decent jobs, decent livelihoodshuman rights, social capital, accountable public service
 - Environmental: resource use efficiency, limit planetary boundary

Core principles of green economy

- Recognizes the role of nature & its limits in sustaining economic growth
- Preserve natural capital & its sustainable use
- Manages & safeguards environmental assets
- Management approaches & technologies that increase resource efficiency & reduce waste
- Internalizes externalities

- Promotes economic, social & environmental justice
