These include the climate crisis, the loss of biological diversity and increasing environmental pollution. UN Secretary-General António Guterres stated: "Making peace with nature is the defining task of the 21st Century" in his [landmark speech on the state of the planet](#). He also explained that "humanity is waging war on nature" that increasingly puts our survival, sustainable development and peace at risk.
