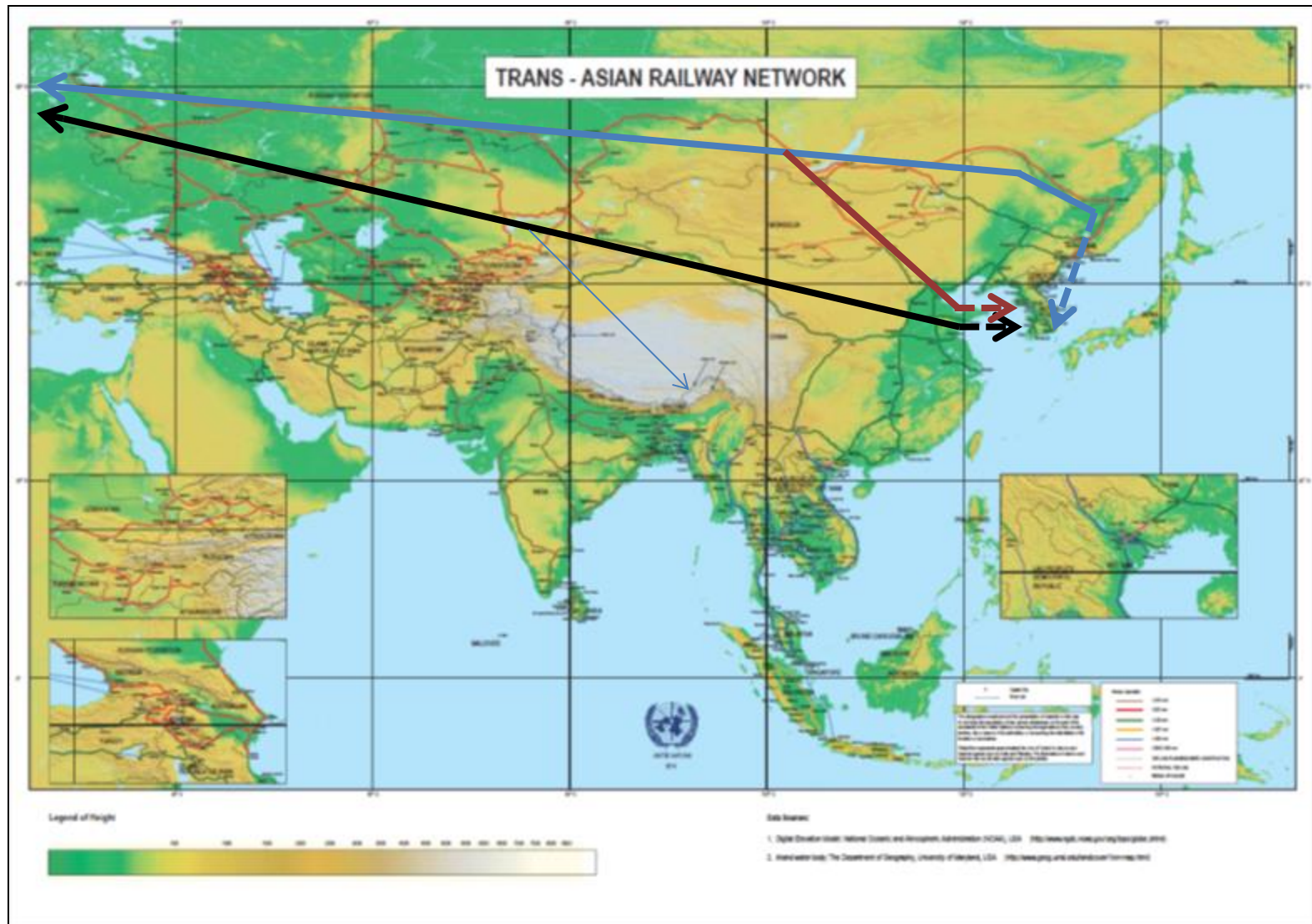
# Objectives of the project

---

- Improving connections of electronic advance information systems for different modes of transport

# Key activities

---

- Collect information and documentation on formalities related to: (i) rail-based intermodal transport with road and maritime segments, (ii) crossing borders, and (iii) use of electronic advance information systems by different modes of transport
- Conduct a study comprised of two components:
  - (i) simplification and streamlining of documents and formalities at seaports and border crossings
  - (ii) improving connections of electronic advance information systems for different modes of transport

# Key activities

---

- Organize expert group meetings to discuss:
  - (i) the simplified and streamlined documents and formalities at seaports and border crossings
  - (ii) the use of electronic advance information systems
- Organize a subregional meeting to review, discuss and adopt the recommendations of the study
