- I. UI/EI Schemes are specific to each country depending on: (a) Circumstances; (b) unemployment feature; © labour market characteristics; (d) existing provisions; (d) (etc...)
- 2. Need to have a clear idea of what should be achieved by the scheme to be adopted PLUS a realistic view of the limits of such instruments
- 3. UI does not solve the unemployment problem: the main objective is to provide TEMPORARY and PARTIAL income replacement (for a defined duration to INSURED persons who lose their job while seeking to obtain a new employment

7 LESSONS FROM ONE COUNTRY'S EXPERIENCE IN IMPLEMENTING UI

- I. CLEARLY identify objectives, significance and impact
- 2. Widely disseminate all information/data to create awareness
- 3. Regularly inspect and review how the system is implemented, to identify faults, to make immediate adjustments and to penalize those responsible

- 4. Convergence of government agencies (single window approach)
- Clearly identify RESPONSIBILITIES: government, employers, workers
