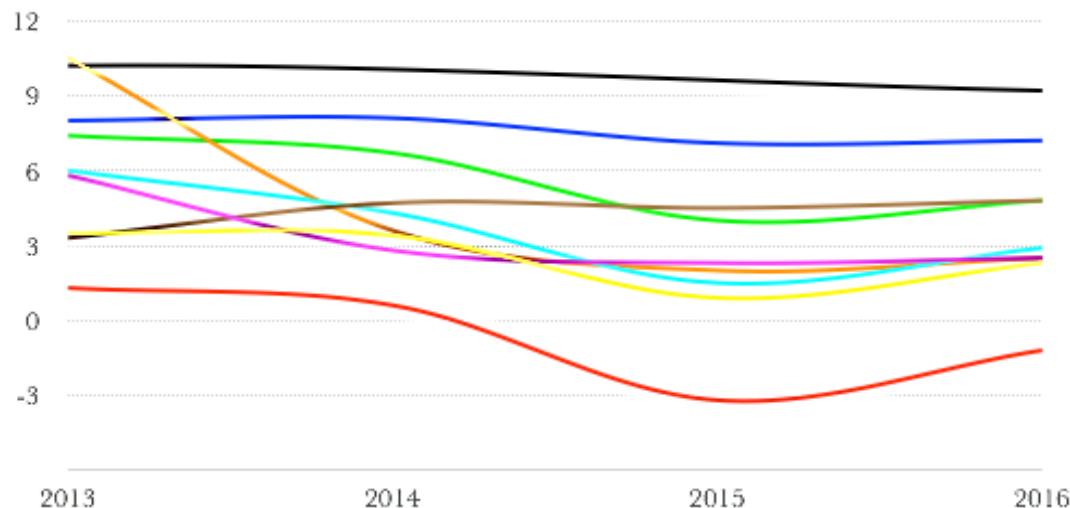
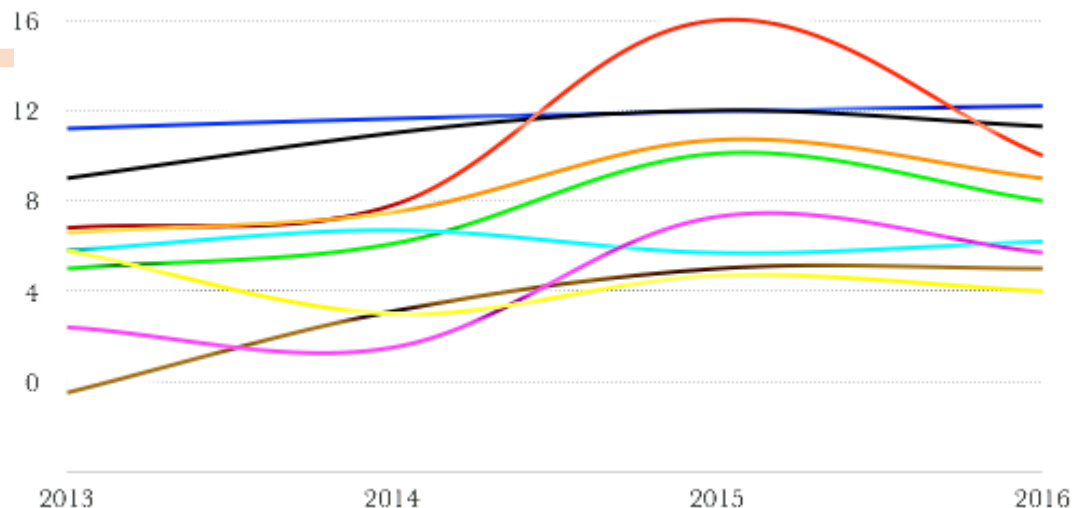

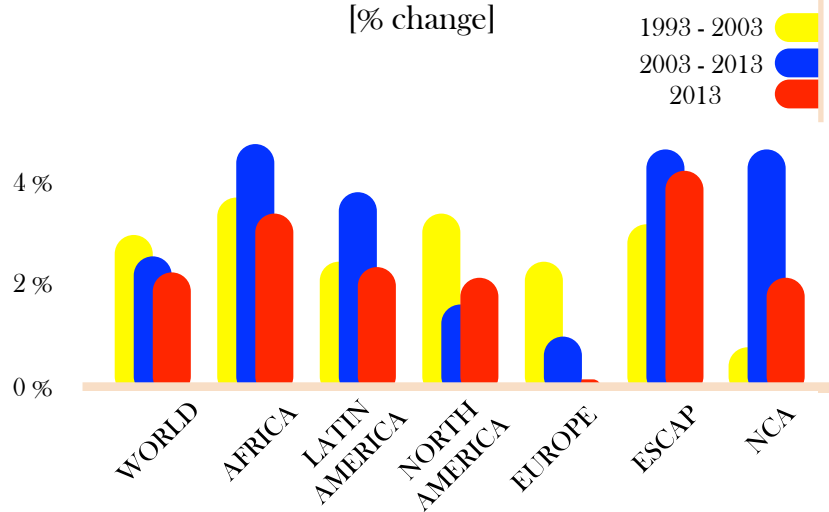
Real GDP Growth [% change per annum]

BACKGROUND
