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What is a Paperless Transit System?

- ✓ Cross-border movement of goods based on electronic documents;
- ✓ Could also include simplified paper-based documents;
- ✓ A process of optimization of transit facilitation measures by means of available and affordable ICT.

Why to promote Paperless Trade?

- ✓ Increase efficiency of trade procedures;
- ✓ Reduce the rate of fraudulent actions.



eTIR Development

- ✓ In 2003, full-scale computerization of the TIR procedures;
- ✓ Mainly aims at replacing the current paper TIR Carnet;
- ✓ The approach: establishment of international, centralized database.

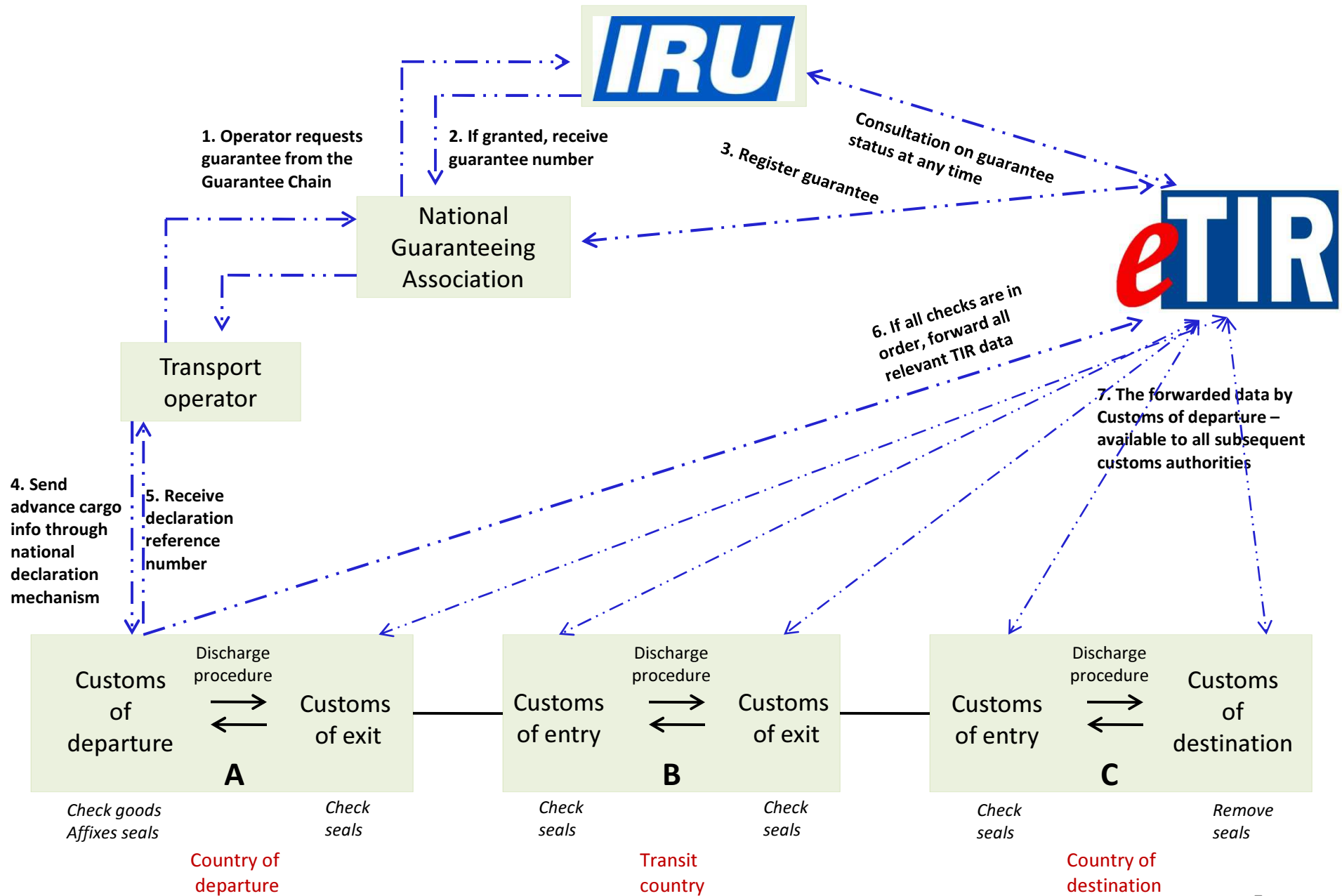
✓ Two fundamental functions of eTIR:

- Management by customs of data on guarantees;
- Exchange of information among customs authorities.

✓ Final objectives:

- Improve the efficiency and quality of the TIR procedures;
- Reduce the risk of fraud
- Improve security in cross-border trade via advanced information allowing risk assessments prior to the arrival of cargo

eTIR benefits

- ✓ Systematic availability of advanced information – risk assessments prior to the arrival of cargos;
- ✓ Prevent false submission of customs declarations;
- ✓ Reduce risk of fraud;
- ✓ Reduce administrative burden;
- ✓ Increase the security and control of TIR operations.
