New Frontiers - Substantive Outlook

- The 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development
 - Ambitious new agenda 17 goals, 169 targets
 - Highlight on Balanced Integration of Economic, Social and Environmental dimensions
 - New Capacity / Knowledge required
- Persistent Food / Hunger Challenges
 - "Sustainable" intensification of agricultural production
 - Innovation anticipated throughout value chains (production, distribution, markets, consumption, etc.)
- Global Call for Climate Action
 - Adaptation / Resilience to CC impacts and disasters
 - Positioning Agriculture in INDC



Assessing the regional trend

- Preliminary assessment of regional trends indicates
 - Progress in MDG poverty / hunger targets, but maybe in sacrifice of environmental and social sustainability
 - Positive trend in agricultural production, but challenges remain with distribution and access
 - Agriculture's contribution to economy and employment stagnant but remains important in inclusive rural development
 - Current agricultural practices put significantly stress on environmental sustainability, including through water and energy uses.
 - Impacts of climate change becomes more evident
