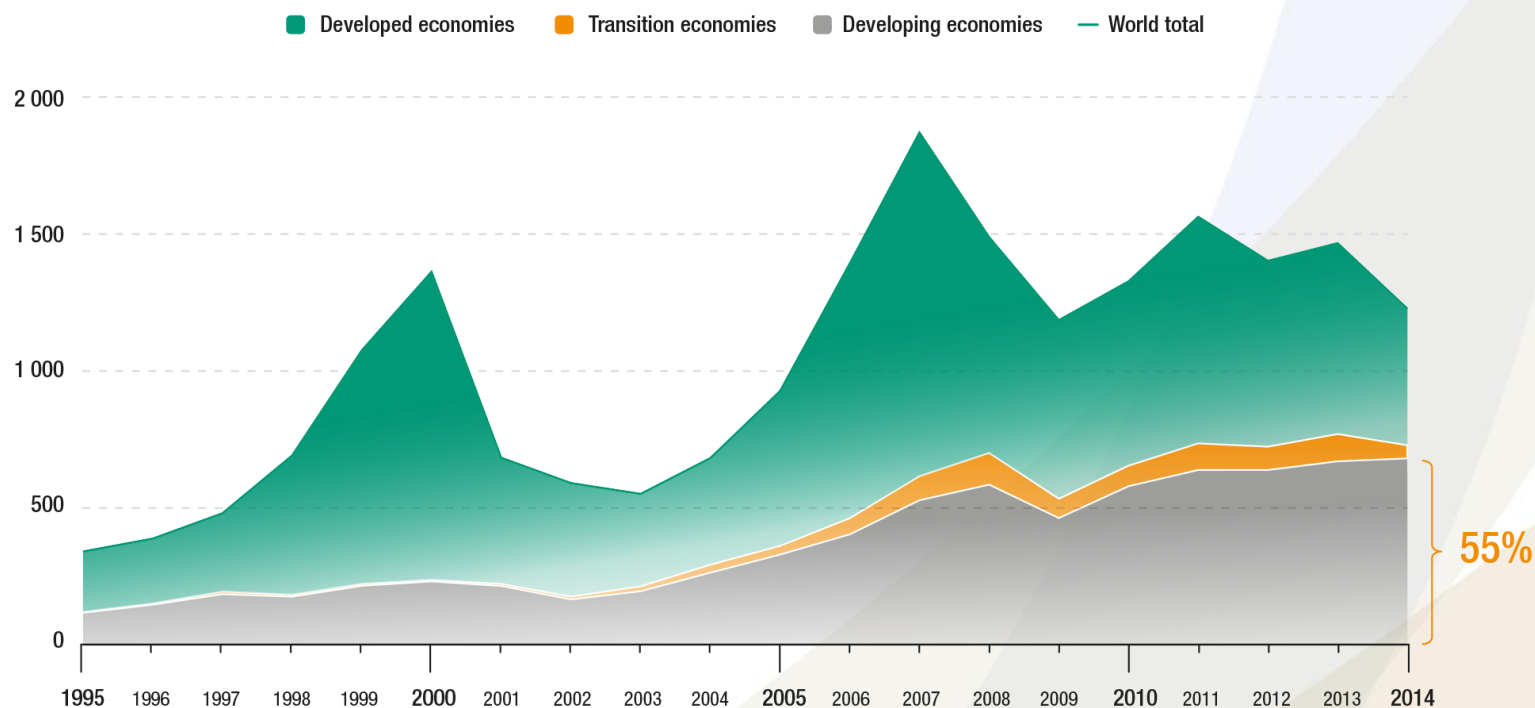

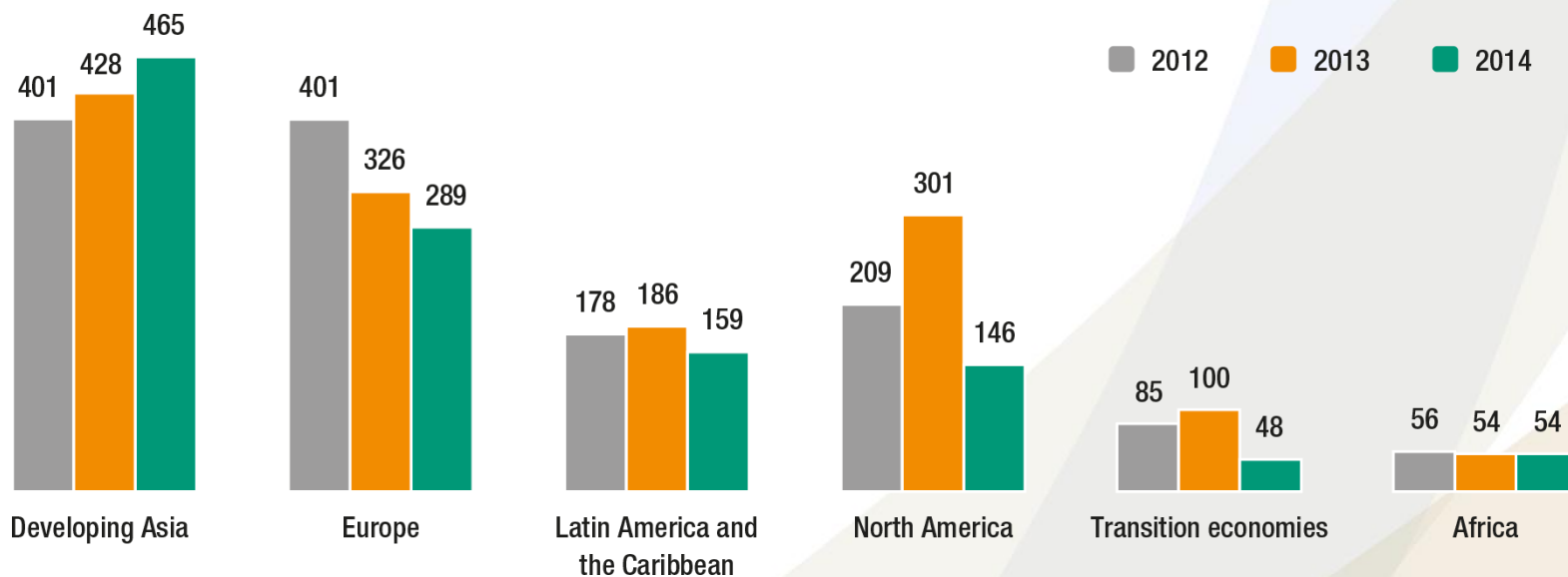
Global FDI flows declined in 2014

(Billions of dollars)



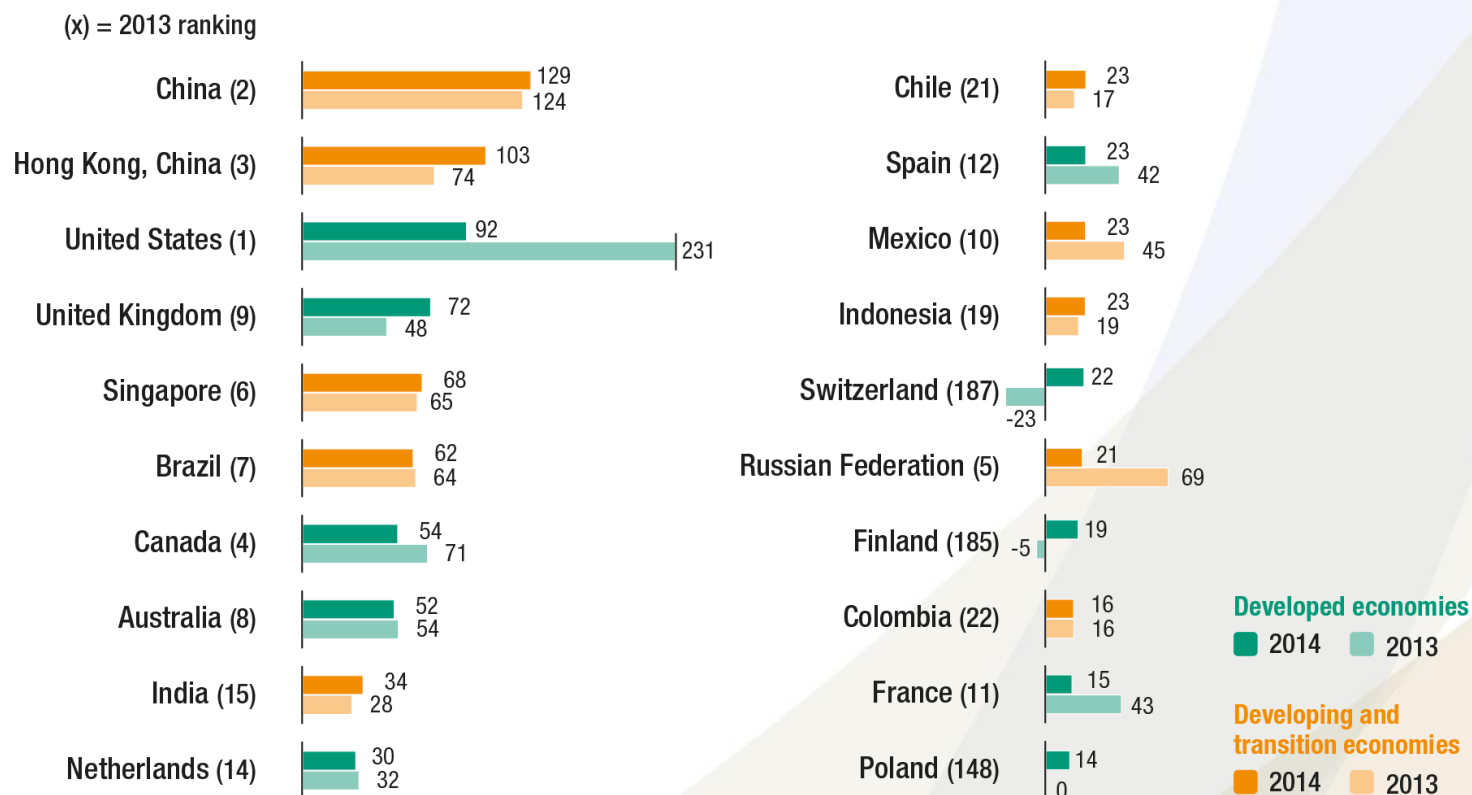
Developing Asia is the largest recipient region in the world

Among the top 10 hosts, 4 are Asian economies

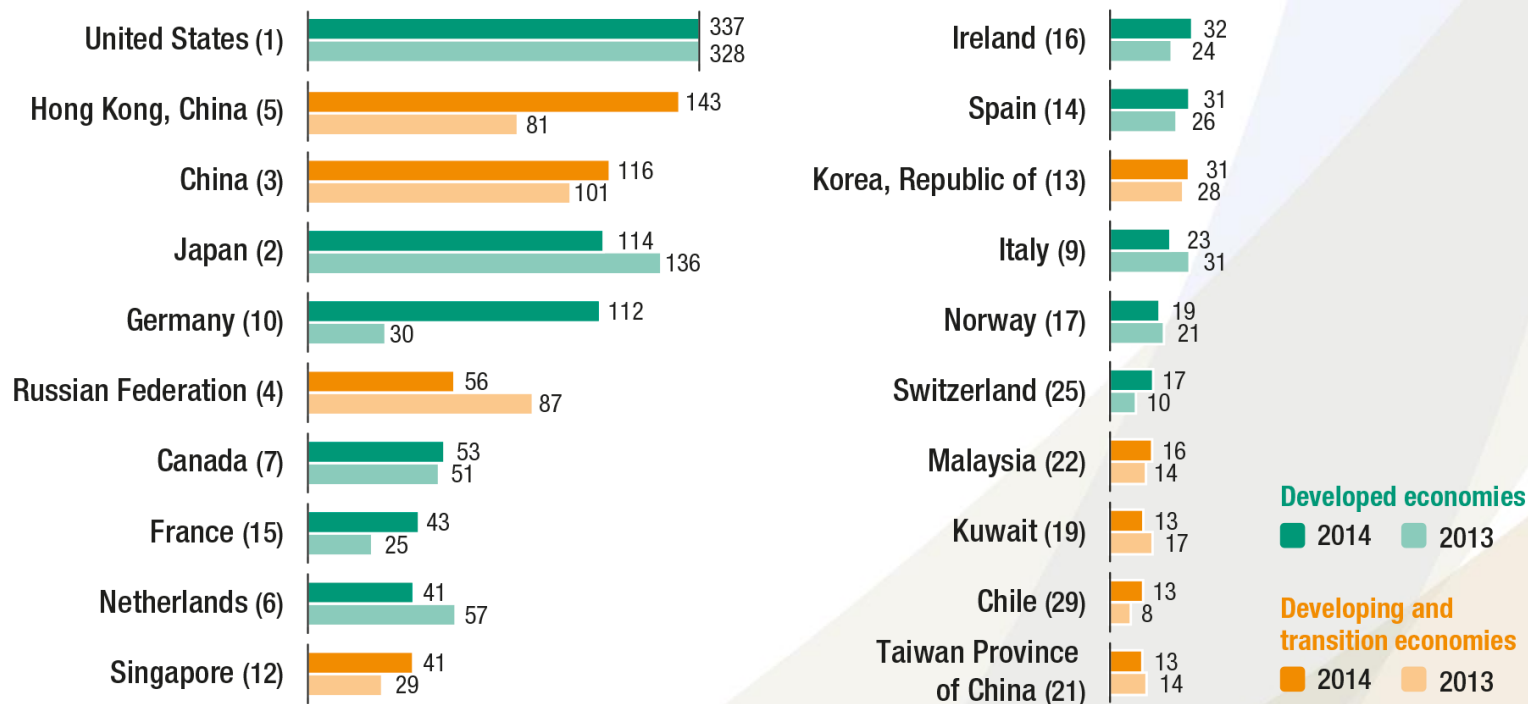
FDI inflows: top 20 host economies, 2013 and 2014 (Billions of dollars)

(x) = 2013 ranking

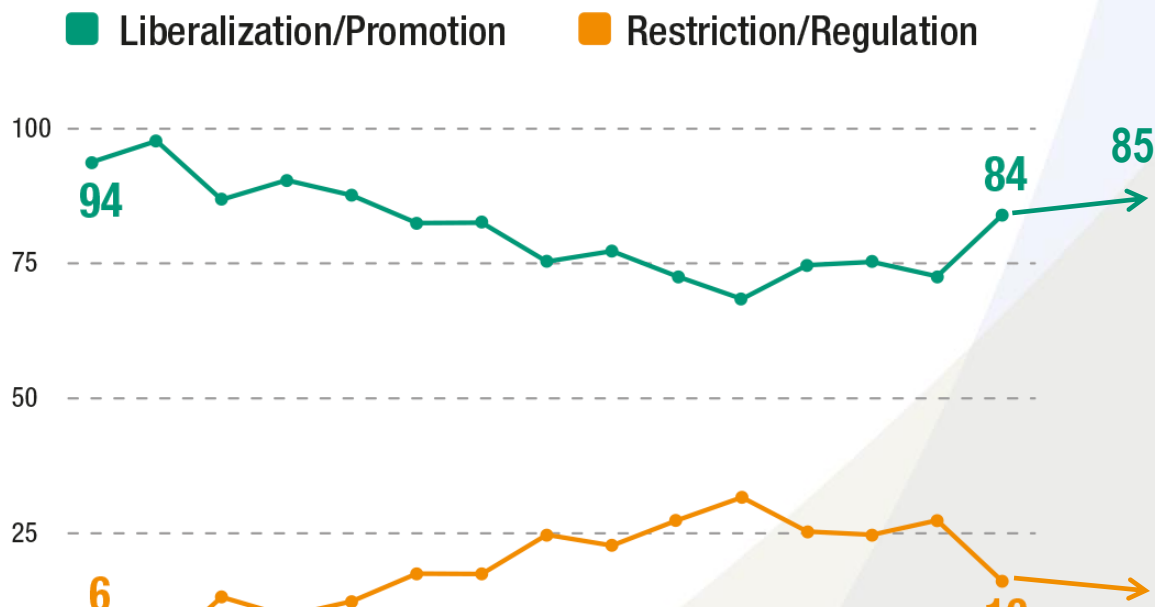
