






# Earthquake 2005 Recovery and Reconstruction





### Earthquake – 8 Oct 2005







#### **Magnitude of the Disaster**



- Pakistan suffered its worst ever natural disaster on the morning of 8 October
   2005
- An earthquake measuring 7.6 on the Richter scale struck the mountainous area of 28,000 square kilometers of Pakistan's Khyber Pakhtunkhwa (KP) and Azad Jummu Kashmir (AJK)
- The death toll was over 73,000 of which around 17,000 were school students



#### **Magnitude of the Disaster**




- Around 3.5 million persons were left homeless, of which at least 60% were women and children
- 600,000 houses, 800 health facilities and 6,200 education institutions destroyed
- Roads measuring 2300 kms destroyed
- 92 bridges rendered useless
- Communication systems and public offices were destroyed and agricultural land, livestock and forests were partially or fully lost


