- › A comprehensive regulatory database containing information entailed in 16000 laws and regulations, with source information.

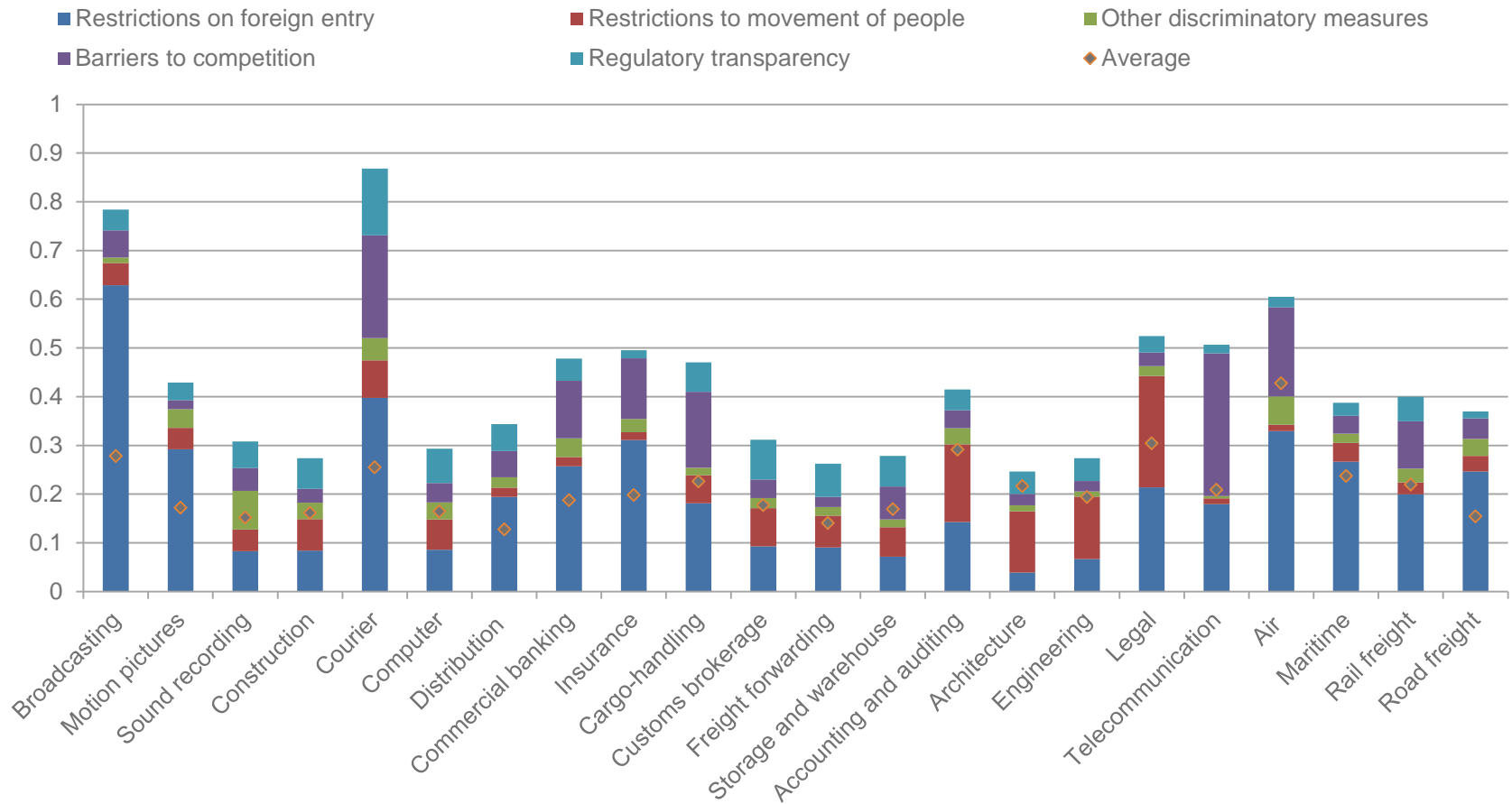


How is it done?

1. Collect information on regulation “on the books”
2. Scoring of individual measures – binary enhanced by:
 - Thresholds
 - Hierarchies and linkages between complementary measures
3. Weighting scheme
4. Scoring and weighting automated:
 - Qualitative information transformed to indicators using a fixed set of rules codified in computer algorithms
5. The index takes values between 0 and 1



China's score on the STRI by sector



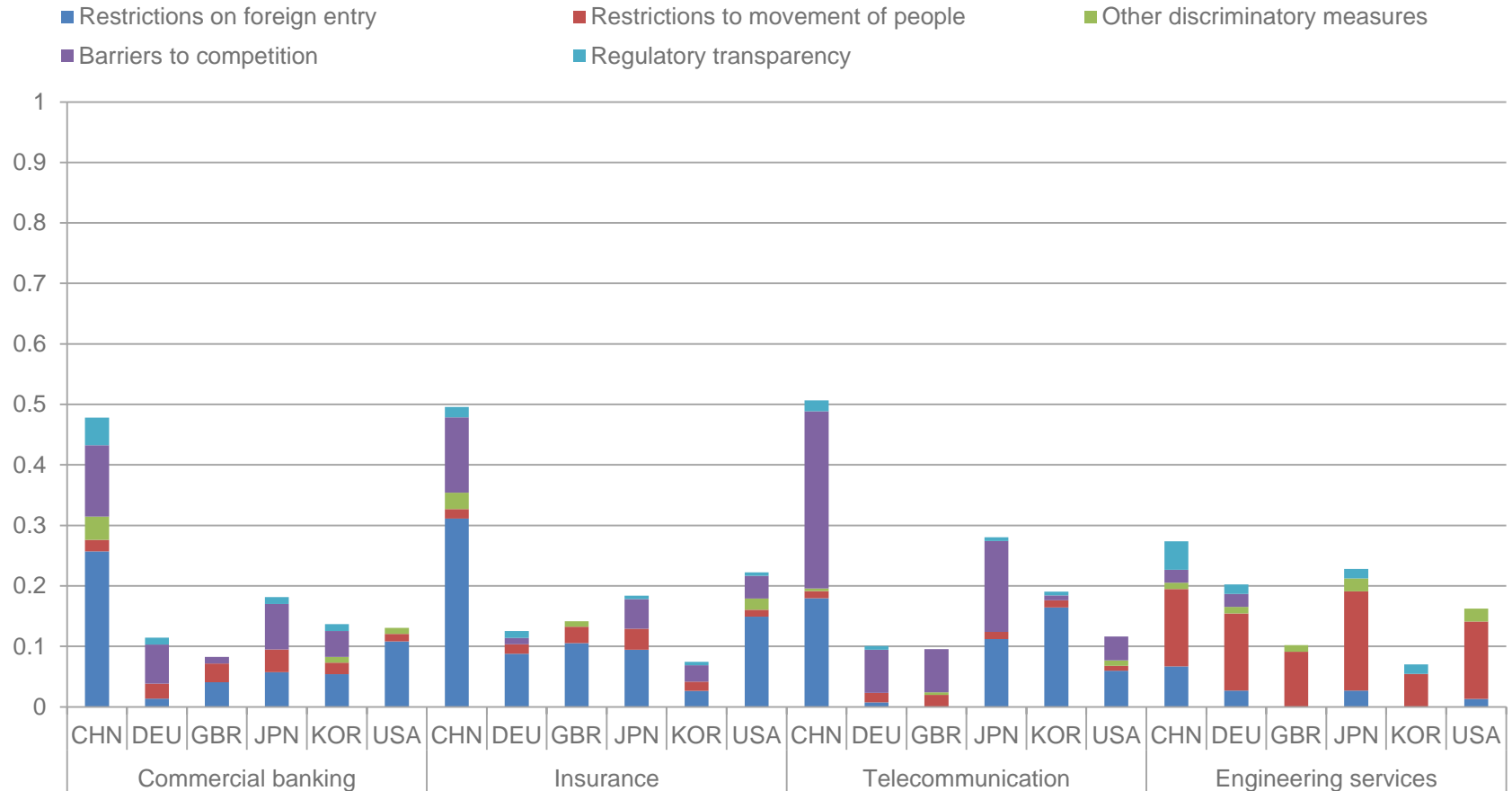


China's score compared to key trading partners, transport and logistics



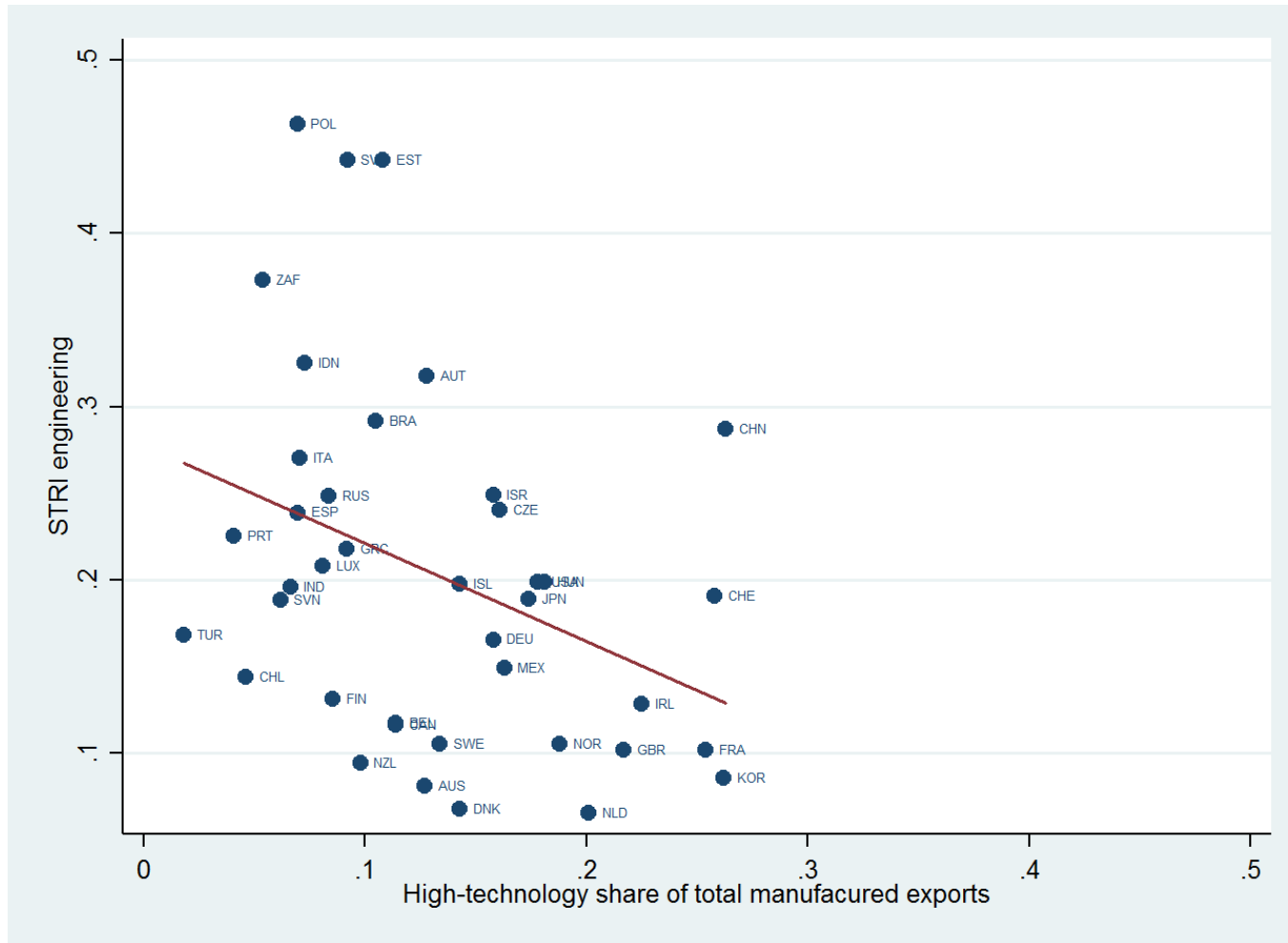


China's score compared to key trading partners, key economic sectors



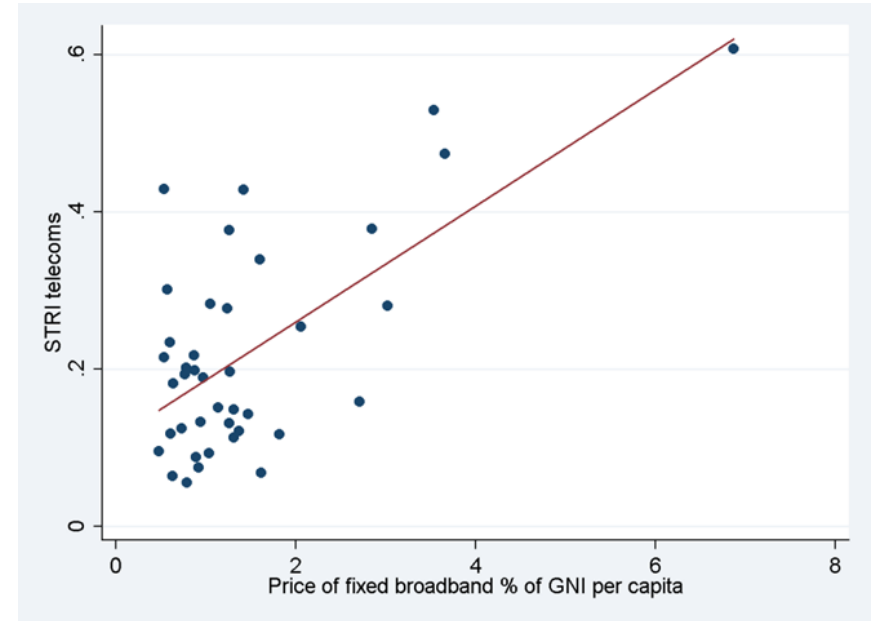
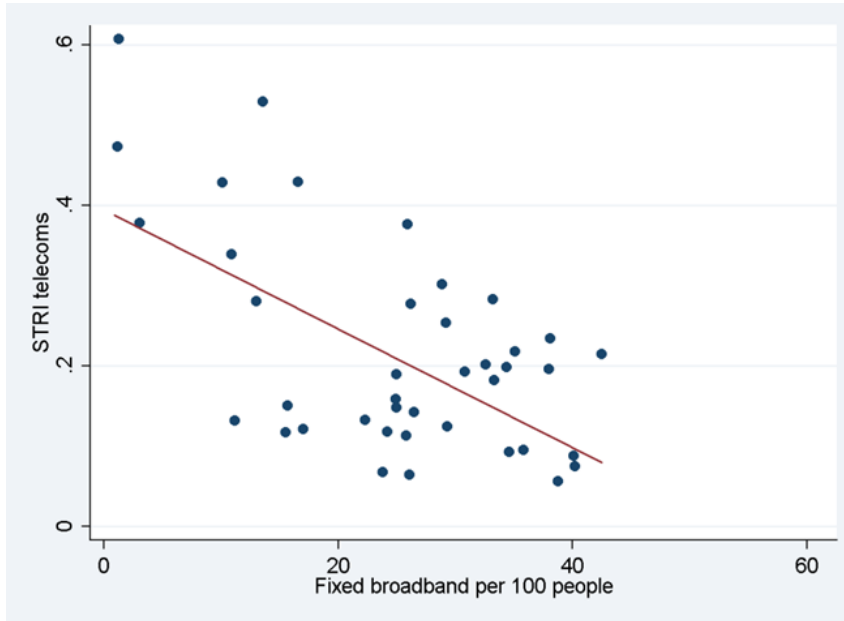
