1520 – 1600	<p>Session 2: Lessons from bilateral initiatives on certificate of origin</p> <p><i>A certificate of origin is a common trade document, used for verifying origin of goods/materials as well as obtaining preferential tariff ratios, where information and communication technology (ICT) is applied as a trade facilitation measure. Electronic certificate of origin (eCO) can bring much time and cost savings to trading community.
