

COTIF - OTIF



COTIF = Convention concerning International Carriage by Rail

- Aim = to establish uniform rules for international rail transport
- Entry into force: 1 July 2006
- Many revisions since 19th century!




OTIF = Intergovernmental organisation for International Carriage by Rail

- 49 Member States (incl. EU since 2011)
- Recent members = Russia, Armenia, Georgia
 → it is expanding towards East
- Based in Bern (Switzerland)


