- Improvement of technology to set aside the difference between track gauges.

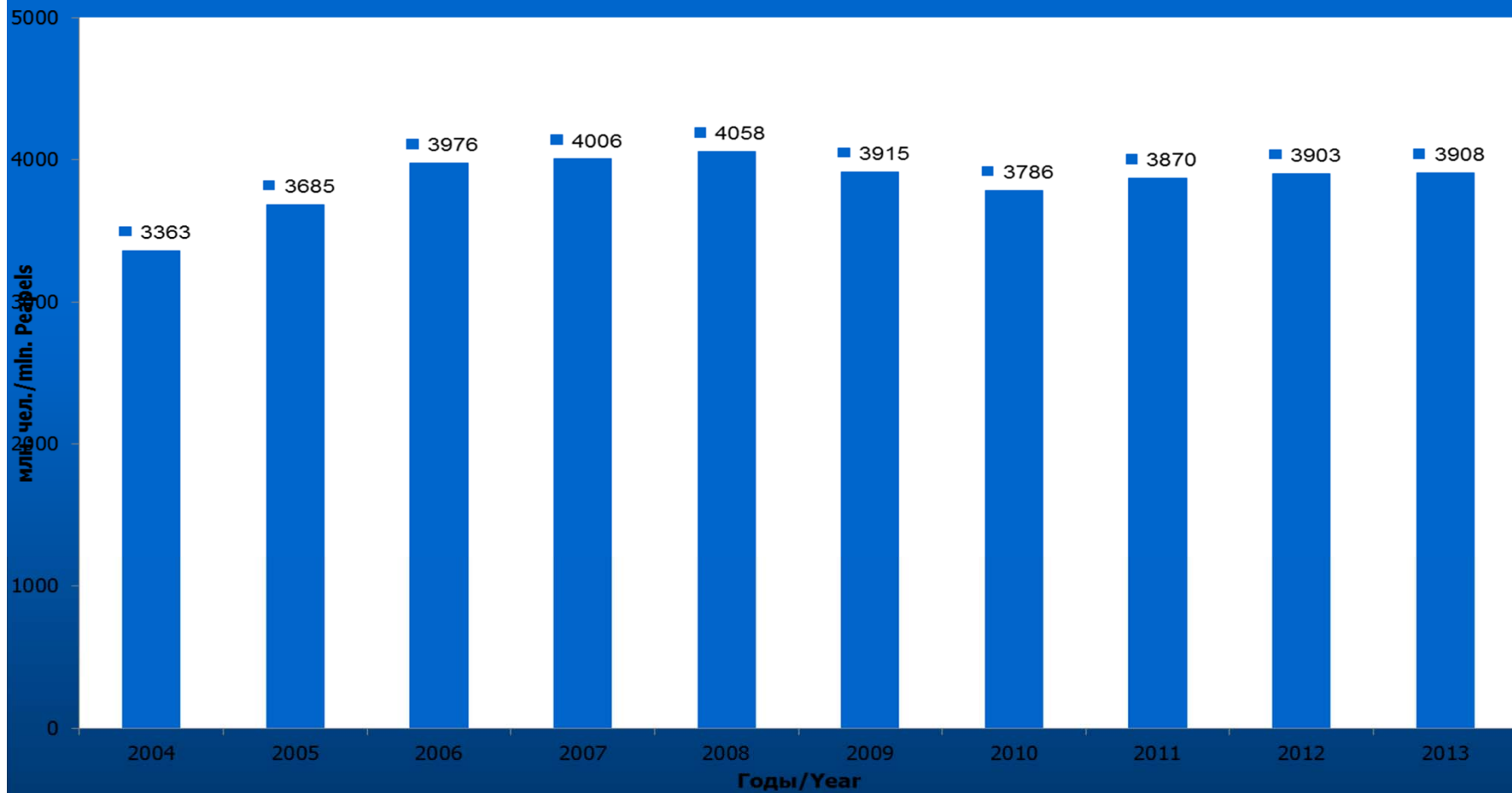


Member Countries of OSJD:

- Freight traffic by rail a year - 5,7 bln. t

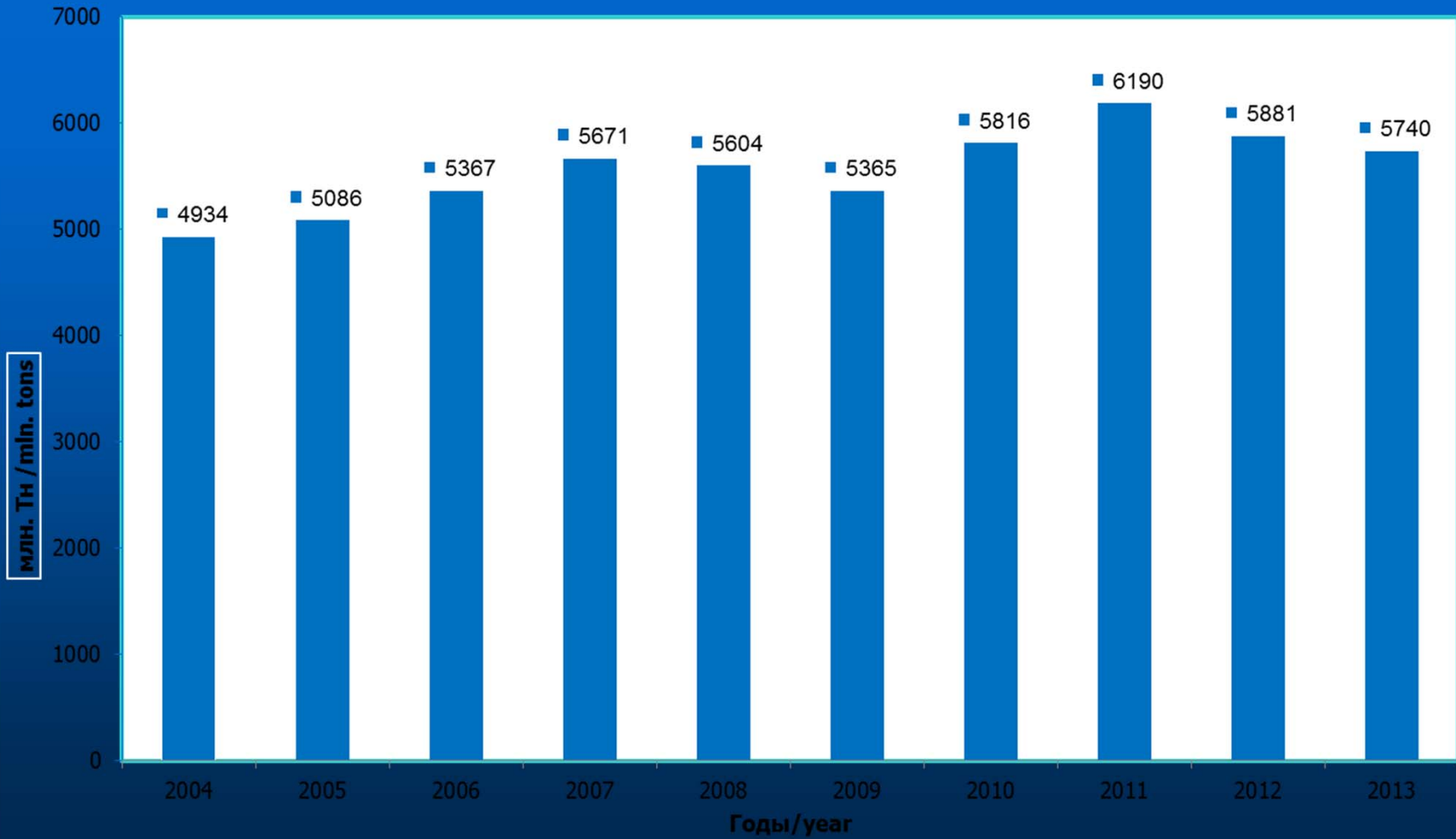


Dynamics of changes in passenger traffic
