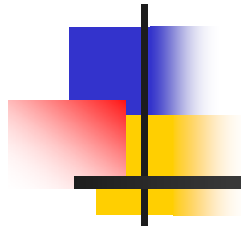

- **Construct “dry ports” at Phuentsholing, Gelephu, and Samdrupjongkhar**
- **Introduce domestic air services**
