- Diagnostics for universalizing sanitation solutions in urban slums – SPARC & WSP
 - National Urban Sanitation Policy
- Cross-cutting Agra Programme – USAID, CURE & World Bank
 - Decentralised, community-led sanitation solutions led to in-situ upgrading and livelihoods support in pilot settlement, city-wide slum upgrading plan and decentralized sanitation initiatives to promote tourism in Agra

Impacts of top-down approach



A small intervention can catalyze change

- CA mission is to support multi-sector urban development initiatives – why sanitation?
- Individual toilets - the change catalysts in Sangli and Agra
- Toilets → Water → Drains → Street alignment and Paving → Street-lighting → livelihoods support
- Integrated approach to tackling infrastructure deficits for sustainable and inclusive urban growth
