Global Leaders Programme on Pro-Poor Public Private Partnership: Scaling Up Off-Grid Rural Electrification in Lao PDR

6 - 12 December 2014 Lao PDR

The Global Institute for Tomorrow's Global Leaders Programme, will be held in collaboration with United Nations Economic and Social Commission for Asia and the Pacific (ESCAP) and the Institute for Renewable Energy Promotion (IREP) from 6 to 12 December 2014. The programme will bring together more than 30 global business leaders from over 15 countries to review ESCAPs Pro-Poor Public-Private Partnership (5P) project. The 5P project is a flagship initiative currently being implemented by ESCAP in Nepal and Lao PDR. The model was previously implemented in Cinta Mekar, Indonesia in which the project established a micro-hydro plant to provide energy for household and for productive uses for pro-poor community development; the Cinta Mekar project has been successfully operating for more than 10 years. The Global Leaders Programme participants are expected to provide concrete business oriented recommendations for the 5P framework and business model, in order allow the project to better engage private sector partners, ensure financial sustainability and position the project for scale-up at the national level.

This week long programme will be hosting a closing forum entitled: "Pro-Poor Public-Private Partnership: Scaling-up off-grid rural electrification in Lao PDR", on 12 December 2014 from 14:00-

16:00 hours at Mercure Hotel in Vientiane.
