Article10: Formalities connected with importation and exportation and transit

### Single Window in the WTO TF Agreement

#### **4 Single Window**

4.1. Members shall endeavour to establish or maintain a single window, enabling traders to *submit documentation* and/or data requirements for importation, exportation or transit of goods through a single entry point to the participating authorities or agencies.

After the examination by the participating authorities or agencies of the documentation and/or data, the results shall be notified to the applicants through the single window in a timely manner.

## Single Window in the WTO TF Agreement

#### **4 Single Window**

4.1.

4.2. In cases where documentation and/or data requirements have already been received through the single window, the same documentation and/or data requirements shall not be requested by participating authorities or agencies except in urgent circumstances and other limited exceptions which are made public.
