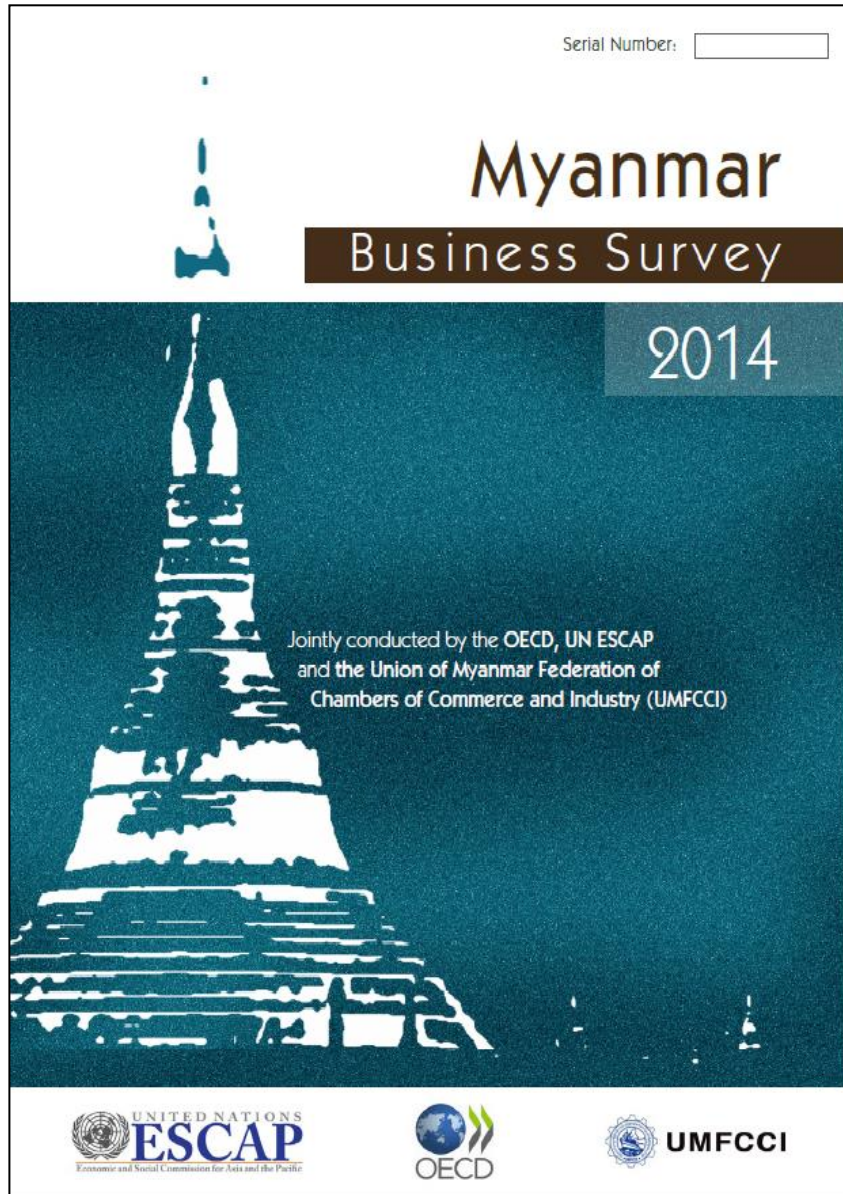

Background

- In Myanmar, a lack of information on the conditions and environment in which both local and foreign businesses operate represents a major obstacle in identifying effective policy recommendations.



- First-ever national wide survey for business
- All sectors, sizes, legal structures, ownerships , nationalities and States/Provinces
- Conducted by ESCAP/OECD/UMFCCI
- Donors: Japan, Germany, Switzerland, The Asia Foundation and UNIDO
- 3 months for data collection

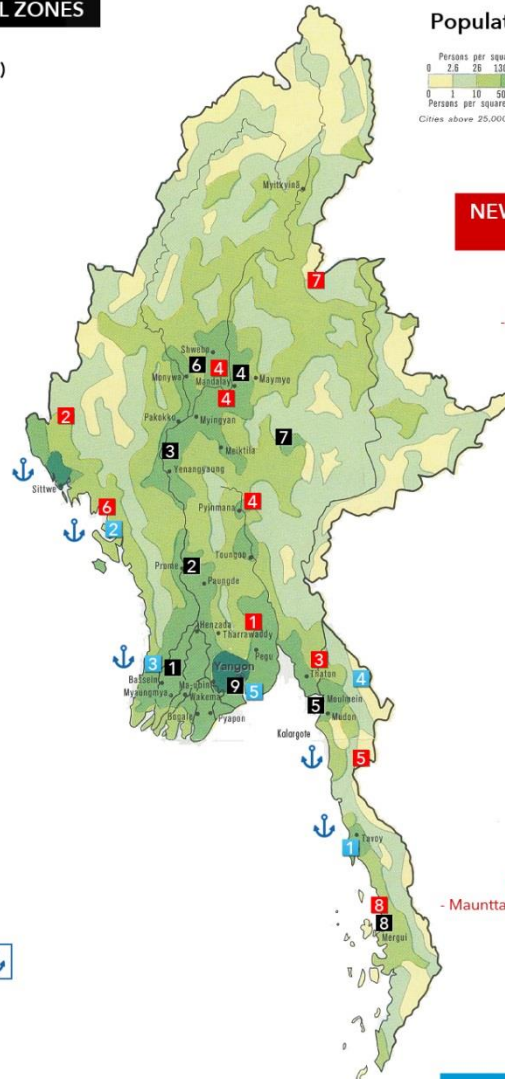
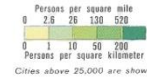

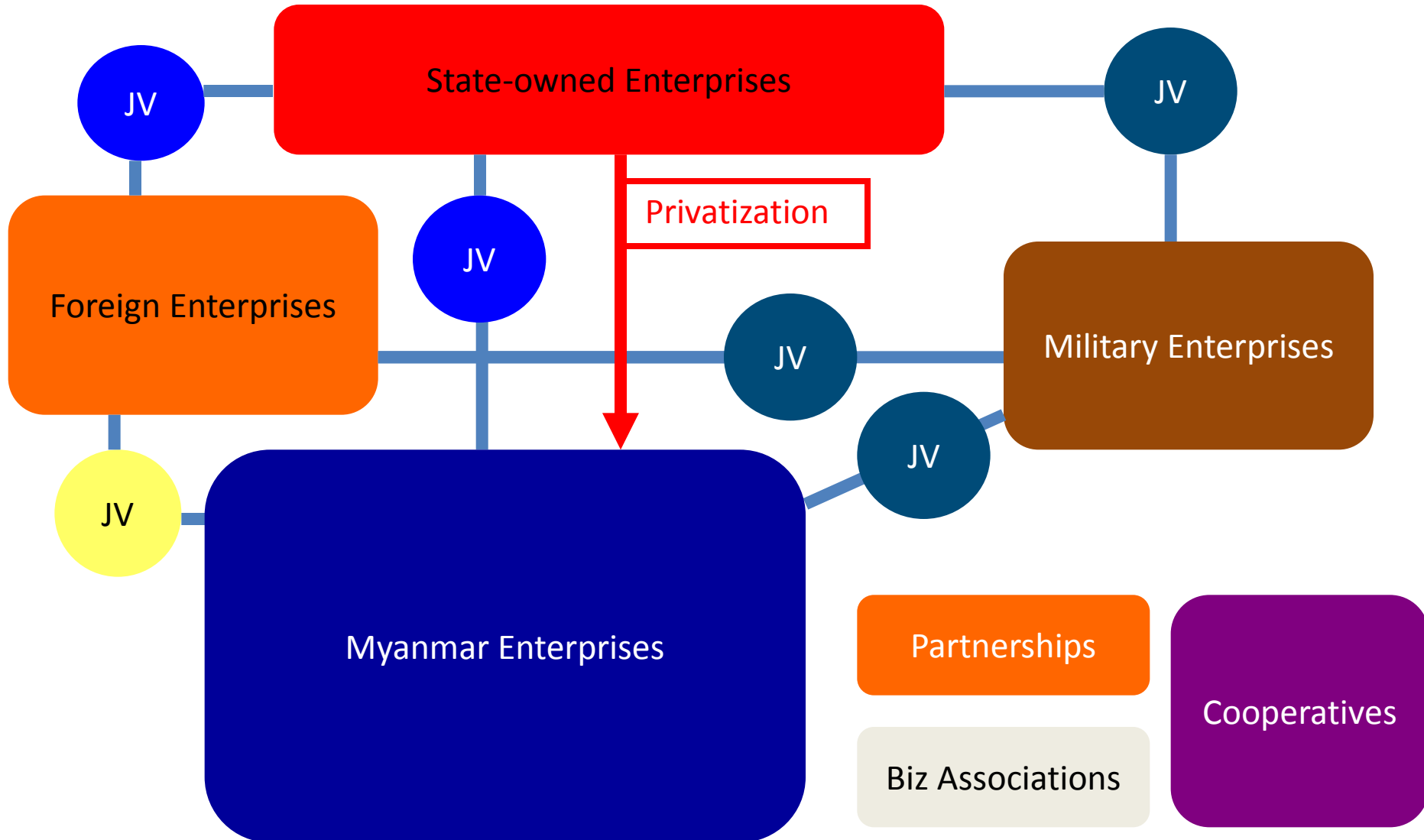
