The Open Working Group on Sustainable Development Goals

- Mandated through the Rio+20 outcome document to develop a set of sustainable development goals "for consideration and appropriate action by the General Assembly at its 68th Session"
- Should be coherent with and integrated into the UN development agenda beyond 2015









OWG mandate

- Three essential requirements for sustainable development:
 - Poverty eradication
 - Changing unsustainable and promoting sustainable patterns of consumption and production
 - Protecting and managing the natural resource base of economic and social development
- Putting people at the centre of sustainable development









Para 247 of the Rio+20 Outcome Document:

"... the SDGs should be action-oriented, concise, easy to communicate, limited in number, aspirational, global in nature and universally applicable to all countries while taking into account different national realities, capacities and levels of development and respecting national policies and priorities"









OWG Outcome Document

- Released after the 13th session of the OWG (14-18 July 2014)
- Proposes a set of 17 Sustainable Development Goals
- Each Goal accompanied by between 5 and 19 targets (total 169 targets)









Goal 1-3

- Goal 1: End poverty in all its forms everywhere
- Goal 2: End hunger, achieve food security and improved nutrition, and promote sustainable agriculture
- Goal 3: Ensure healthy lives and promote wellbeing for all at all ages
