The Open Working Group on Sustainable Development Goals

- Mandated through the Rio+20 outcome document to develop a set of sustainable development goals “*for consideration and appropriate action by the General Assembly at its 68th Session*”
- Should be coherent with and integrated into the UN development agenda beyond 2015



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OWG mandate

- Three essential requirements for sustainable development:
 - Poverty eradication
 - Changing unsustainable and promoting sustainable patterns of consumption and production
 - Protecting and managing the natural resource base of economic and social development
- Putting people at the centre of sustainable development



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Para 247 of the Rio+20 Outcome Document:

“... the SDGs should be **action-oriented, concise, easy to communicate, limited in number, aspirational, global in nature** and **universally applicable** to all countries while taking into account different national realities, capacities and levels of development and respecting national policies and priorities”



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OWG Outcome Document

- Released after the 13th session of the OWG (14-18 July 2014)
- Proposes a set of 17 Sustainable Development Goals
- Each Goal accompanied by between 5 and 19 targets (total 169 targets)



Goal 1-3

- **Goal 1: End poverty in all its forms everywhere**
- **Goal 2: End hunger, achieve food security and improved nutrition, and promote sustainable agriculture**
- **Goal 3: Ensure healthy lives and promote well-being for all at all ages**
