Assumptions for Renewed Partnership

- Regional cooperation accelerates the attainment of sustained and rapid economic growth, reducing poverty, and economic disparity.
- Countries will continue with the unfinished MDGs
- Shared vision of inclusive development



Regional cooperation should provide public goods that would mitigate the realization of risks

- Ensure financial stability
- Knowledge sharing
- Effective control of communicable diseases
- Disaster risk reduction, quick recovery from natural disasters
- Climate change adaptation
- Ensure peace and security



Challenges for effective regional cooperation in support the implementation of a post 2015 development agenda

- Building stronger cooperation through improved data production: timeliness, regularity, reliability → quick and informed decisions
 - Comparable: standard operational definition
 - Common time period/s
 - Early warning/red flag for share development agenda: no only SDG indicators but indicators for risks factors
- Continuing capacity building
 - Data collection, analysis, financing options

Challenges for effective regional cooperation in support the implementation of a post 2015 development agenda (cont'd)

- Financing: availability and sustainability
 - Predictability of ODA
 - Continuing discussion towards a fair trading system and a stable financial system
 - Debt management and sustainability
- Innovation
