






Optimizing state revenue while maintaing investment climate and environmental integrity


Strategies


- 1. Fiscal incentives for strategic economic activities that supports both investment climate and environmental conservation
- 2. Strengthening taxation administrative system
- 3. Broadening tax base by improving tax awareness and compliance
- 4. Improving natural resource revenue through enhancing cost recovery efficiency lifting production while still maintaining environmental integrity
- 5. Reviewing non tax state revenue
- 6. Increasing oil lifting through development of new oil wells

























Indonesia Strategy to Expand the Tax Base & Narrowing the Tax Gap



A. Tax Measures (Mapping – Profiling – Benchmarking)

- 1. Tax Policy Reforms

 Broaden tax base by lowering tax compliance cost, ie, through reforms in taxation laws (VAT, Income Tax, General Provision), among others:
- a) Improvement in legal certainty, fairness and simplicity;
- b) Introduction of single and lower corporate income tax rates;
