NDM PLAN 1995

- In 1991 the Government through the NDMO office put up a proposal to develop a National Disaster Management Plan to replace the old and outdated EMSEC Manual
- The Plan incorporates disaster experiences of the past, and recommendations of ideas after series of four disaster management seminars convened in 1991 to examine & review EMSEC Manual and make draft replacement documents





NDMO ACT 1998

- The Government managed to adopt the first Fiji NDM Act 1998 approved in parliament after 19 years from NDMO establishment (1979-1998)
- This NDM Act 1998 was formulated from the NDM Plan 1995 (after 3 years)
- The NDM Act 1998 is currently in use


